4.1 Consideration of a Cost-Sharing Agreement with Otay Water District for the Recycled Water Market Study

That the Engineering and Operations Committee recommends that the Governing Board Authorize the General Manager to execute the Agreement with Otay Water District for cost-sharing of the Recycled Water Market Study, estimated to cost \$300,000, with any costs not funded through a grant to be equally shared between Sweetwater Authority and Otay Water District, and any grant proceeds to be distributed equally between Sweetwater Authority and Otay Water District.

4.2 Consideration of U.S. Geological Survey Proposal for Seawater Intrusion and Land Subsidence Investigations

That the Engineering and Operations Committee recommends that the Governing Board authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with the United States Geological Survey to perform an investigation of seawater intrusion and land deformation in accordance with their proposal dated May 23, 2023, for a total cost of \$342,000, of which the Authority would fund a not-to-exceed amount of \$282,000, with remaining funds to be contributed by the United States Geological Survey.
