WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar lawful money of the United States, to each of them in hand paid and before the ensealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold, released and confirmed and by these presents do bargain, grant, sell, release and confirm unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all the water flowing in the stream called Sweetwater River, and all other streams owned by the parties of the first part in said County of San Diego - with the right to divert the same from its natural channel, at any point or points and to conduct the same over, along and across any of the lands of the parties of the first part in said County by means of flumes, canals or aqueducts, together with free ingress, egress and recess to and for the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, and its and their servants and workmen with horses, carts and carriages, at all convenient times and seasons, in, along and upon said flumes, canals & aqueducts for the amending, cleansing and repairing the same, with liberty and privileges for that purpose to dig and take stones and earth from the adjacent land of the parties of the first part, when and as often as need be, or occasion requires. To have and to hold all and singular the premises and privileges hereby mentioned or granted or intended so to be, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part its successors
